The 6-month Scholars Transforming through Research (STR) advocacy program was developed to broaden participation across disciplines in undergraduate research allowing engagement from students at varied stages of the undergraduate research process. The program takes a team of up to four individuals - one mentor and up to three students - and immerses them, to gain valuable skills in communicating the impact of their undergraduate research experience to a variety of audience members and stakeholders through congressional meetings and virtual workshops.
