Undergraduate research experiences at Michigan State University are broadly defined to include scholarly, creative, and artistic activities that lead to new knowledge, improve problem-solving capabilities, offer original or historical theory and interpretation, and/or produce art or creative performances. A collaborative effort between students and their research mentors, undergraduate research and creative activities are interactive, discovery-based experiences that teach and engage students about the numerous components involved in the research and creative process. Research and creative opportunities occur in and outside of the formal curriculum.
