

UURAF Creative Arts Showcase | Judge Instructions

Thank you for volunteering to evaluate presentations at the University Undergraduate Research and Arts Forum (UURAF). **All evaluations must be complete by 10:00 PM Eastern on Saturday, April 12th.** Our hope is that you will engage presenters in meaningful dialogue about their research and provide constructive and supportive feedback to help them improve their presentations.

Select one creative art presentation that should win first place. After reviewing each presentation, both in-person and [online](#), identify the first-place winner on the spreadsheet shared with you earlier.

Judging Criteria: Excellent (10-8 pts) – Good (7-5 pts) – Fair (4-2 pts) – Needs Improvement (1-0 pts)

Scoring in each category ranges from 10 (best) to 0 (low) with a total possible score of 30.

- Context & Significance
- Content Knowledge
- Presentation Style & Answering Questions

As you review presentations, please recognize the broad types of research and creative scholarship represented as you seek to provide comparable evaluations.

- UURAF is an educational setting open to all disciplines and to all undergraduate students who will benefit from improved presentation and communication skills. It provides opportunity for students to communicate their mentored scholarly and creative projects to a broad audience.
- Presentations represent projects ranging from short-term independent study, to semester (or longer) class-based research, to multi-year group research programs, and more.
- While students most often present a comprehensive overview of the entire project, some may choose to focus only on the inspiration/process of developing a project or on the potential impact of the project in their disciplines or in broader society.
- In addition to completed projects, students are encouraged to present preliminary concepts, theoretical proposals, literature reviews, or in-progress or future projects.

Submitting Evaluations:

A computer, tablet, or smart phone is required to submit evaluations. Use the link or QR code to access the evaluation form.
