Registration closes May 22 at 11:59 PM. Upon registration, you will receive further information a few weeks prior to program start.

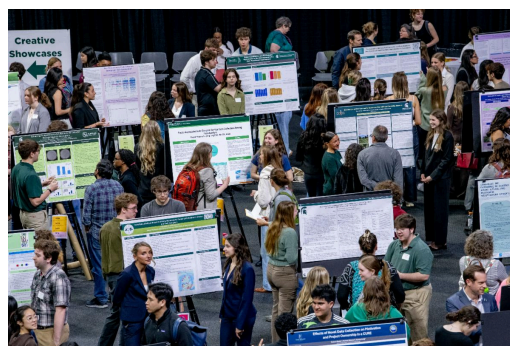
