Jaída is a first-gen college student at Michigan State University, majoring in Criminal Justice with a minor in Peace & Justice Studies.

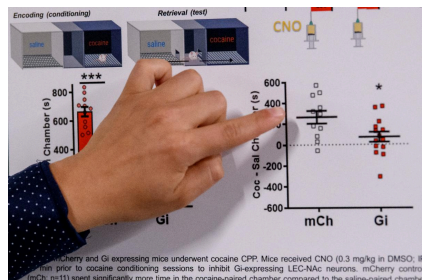

Her research on the 1820 Amity Hall plantation in Jamaica combines archival work and digital tools to shed light on slavery's impact. 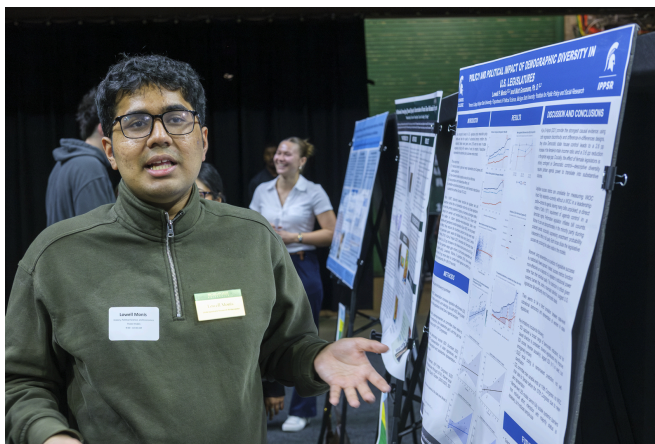


Call for Posters
